Roseville Connections One-Stop reopens at new location

ROSEVILLE – The Roseville Connections One-Stop, the place to go for job-hunting help, veterans services, and Unemployment Insurance (UI), has reopened at a new location in Roseville.

Its new home is at 115 Ascot Dr., Suite 180, according to the California Employment Development Department (EDD).

Though its address is new, its services are not.

The Roseville Connections One-Stop still offers: veterans services, job search workshops, job training information, computers for job searching, assistance for older workers, and access to phones and computers so displaced workers can file for UI.

The partners at the One-Stop remain the same too. They are: EDD, Golden Sierra Job Training Agency, Experience Works, and NorCal Center on Deafness.
