Sarah also credits the job club and placement coaches at the Workforce Development Board of Solano County with helping her achieve success. With a lot of persistence and encouragement from her coach, Sarah landed two jobs in the beauty industry, a field she's always been passionate about.

Today, Sarah is working two part-time jobs as a beauty ambassador and receptionist with Bare & Beauty and A Little Insight Ultrasound Center. "I'm open for my future!" said Sarah. "I can see myself going into management within the retail beauty industry with Bare & Beauty, or possibly learning to be an ultrasound technician and getting my certificate."
