Deaf and Hard of Hearing Services (DHH) SFP PY 2015/16 Questions and Answers April 28, 2015

- 1. Can we submit several proposals from the same agency?
 Yes. An agency may submit one proposal for one geographical area or for multiple areas in California. An agency may also submit multiple proposals for multiple areas in California.
- 2. Would individuals being served in the Department of Rehabilitation Workability III Program be eligible for services with this grant? This grant provides services to all deaf and/or hard of hearing individuals seeking employment services at the current 17 America's Job Center of California SM (AJCC) sites. This also includes any proposed site(s) successfully funded through this Solicitation For Proposal (SFP). Services will be limited to American Sign Language (ASL) interpreting for programs provided at AJCC sites without DHH representatives.
- 3. Is there a required amount for matching funds, in-kind or cash as described in Exhibit A, Proposal Narrative, Section VI, Resource Utilization? No. The SFP does not require a specific amount for matching funds, in-kind contributions, or cash.
- 4. What is the basis for adding new language related to overtime hours and pay to the DHH/SFP 2015/16? The new language, related to overtime hours and pay, added in Section 2B, was included to serve as a reminder. It also reiterates that funding will only be approved for services provided during the normal office hours and days at the designated AJCC site where DHH staff are co-located.
- 5. Are the required Exhibit forms, 'A' through 'D' and the 'COVER/SIGNATURE PAGE' available in a format which allows the end-user to complete on-line and download? Yes. Potential bidders may download copies of the DHH/SFP 2015/16 in MS-Word format at Solicitations for Proposal. The 'COVER/SIGNATURE PAGE' and the Exhibit forms are located at the end of the proposal.
