SUBJECT: LWIA FINAL PERFORMANCE GOALS FOR PY 2012-13

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Purpose:

This Directive publishes the final Local Workforce Investment Areas (LWIA) performance goals for Program Year (PY) 2012-13 Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth.

Scope:

This Directive applies to all LWIAs.

Effective Date:

This Directive is effective on the day of issuance.

This directive finalizes Workforce Services Draft Directive WSDD-80, issued for comment on March 1, 2013. There were no comments received during the draft comment period. Retain this Directive until further notice.

BACKGROUND:

The State is required to reach agreement with the Secretary of Labor on state-level performance goals for WIA Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth Programs. WIA Section 136(c)(2) states that the Local Workforce Investment Board (LWIB), chief elected official, and the Governor shall negotiate and reach agreement on the local levels of performance.

POLICY AND PROCEDURES:

This directive provides the final LWIA performance goals for the Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth Programs for PY 2012-13. The LWIA's Youth performance goals are the same as the State levels and will not be negotiated for PY 2012-13 at the individual LWIA's level.

ACTION:

This Directive should be brought to the attention of Program Administrators, staff, and the LWIB.
