SUBJECT: AMERICAN RECOVERY & REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) RR FUNDING

The purpose of this Information Notice is to announce the formula-based Rapid Response (RR) funding being provided to Local Workforce Investment Areas (LWIA) for the period from February 17, 2009, through June 30, 2010. This funding is provided by the ARRA and is distributed based on the formula described in Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Directive [WIAD05-18](#).

The amount of funding being provided to each LWIA is shown in the column of the attachment under the heading, "Total PY 08-09 ARRA Formula-Based Funding." As noted, the funding may be expended retroactively to February 17, 2009.

This funding is being provided to each of California's LWIAs to allow them to implement the policies adopted by the California Workforce Investment Board, as described in WIAD05-18. Each award will be used to defray the cost of required and allowable RR activities in response to layoffs, business closures, and natural disasters. These formula RR funds have been placed into one Grant Code (106) in each LWIA's R9705XX subgrant.

Expenditures for activities other than those described in WIA regulations Sections 665.310, 665.320, and 667.262(b) will not be reimbursed by the State under the formula RR grant code. These activities must be paid with other WIA funds or with non-WIA funds.
