SUBJECT: PAY FOR SUCCESS PILOT PROJECTS

On June 14, 2012, the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL), Employment and Training Administration announced approximately \$20 million in Pay for Success grants, funded out of the Workforce Innovation Fund second round of funding. The Workforce Innovation Fund supports innovative approaches to the design and delivery of employment and training services that generate long-term improvements in the performance of the public workforce system, both in terms of positive results for job seekers and employers, and cost-effectiveness. Grants awarded under this announcement will fund pilots of a Pay for Success model, an innovative funding strategy for achieving specific social service outcomes.

The DOL expects to fund approximately one to three grants with a maximum individual grant amount of \$12 million for a 48-month project period. There is no minimum amount for any one grant award. Eligible applicants include state, local, or tribal governmental entities.
