The Employment Development Department, in coordination with the California Workforce Investment Board and the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency, announces the availability of up to \$4 million of Workforce Investment Act Governor's Discretionary 15 Percent funds (\$2 million) and 25 Percent Dislocated Worker Additional Assistance funds (\$2 million) in a Veterans' Employment-Related Assistance Program Solicitation for Proposal (SFP).

The goal of this initiative is to promote the use of industry sector strategies as the framework for addressing the need to help veterans transition into high-wage, high-growth occupations using their skill sets obtained in the military. Given the priority to target resources to the significant number of veterans separating from military service, this SFP's focus is on recently separated veterans.

Proposals will be accepted from public and private non-profit organizations, private for-profit organizations, Local Workforce Investment Boards, education and training providers, and faith-based/community based organizations. Individuals are not eligible to apply.

Proposal applications must be received NO later than Tuesday, April 23, 2013, before 3 p.m. Questions regarding the SFP will be accepted until March 27, 2013, via e-mail at WSBSFP2@edd.ca.gov. The SFP, as well as related information, is available on the [Workforce Development SFP](#) Web page.
