SUBJECT: GRANT FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR VETERANS SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS

The purpose of this Information Notice is to advise the workforce community of grant funding opportunities for veterans service organizations. These grant funds are made available by the federal government and by private foundations, and will be awarded to qualifying veterans service organizations that successfully apply. The grants are intended to support programs in the areas of education, employment, housing, and health/mental health with an emphasis on active duty service members, veterans, and their families.
