The purpose of this Information Notice is to encourage collaboration between America's Job Center of CaliforniaSM (AJCC) staff, and community-based and faith-based Job Clubs in order to improve employment and training services to job seekers.

Job Clubs are a beneficial resource for job seekers because they provide opportunities to share job search techniques, learn about careers and programs, share professional networks, manage the challenges associated with unemployment, and receive peer support. They are usually organized by a volunteer facilitator, open to the public, and held in small group settings with five to 30 participants.
