The Employment Development Department (EDD) announces the availability of up to \$250,000 in grant funds through a Campesino de California Outreach Solicitation for Proposals (SFP). The purpose of this SFP is to secure a provider that will develop and deliver 12 printed publications designed to provide Migrant Seasonal Farm Workers (MSFW) and their families, information about the EDD services and 12 one-hour radio talk shows, each supporting one of the corresponding publications. These products will provide MSFWs timely information on the various programs and services offered through the EDD, including the H-2A Agricultural worker program.

The SFP is open to non-profit public or private agencies, community and faith-based organizations, tribal government, and educational institutions. Individuals are not eligible to apply.
