SUBJECT: GRANT APPLICATION OPPORTUNITY - ENVIRONMENTAL JOB TRAINING

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to fund 17 “Environmental Workforce Development and Job Training Programs” nationwide at up to \$200,000 each.

These three-year programs will recruit, train, and place unemployed and under-employed residents of communities impacted by environmental issues with the skills needed to secure full-time employment in the environmental field. The programs will ensure that residents living in communities historically affected by economic disinvestment, health disparities, and environmental contamination have an opportunity to reap the benefits of revitalization and environmental cleanup in these areas.

Eligible applicants include general purpose local governments, redevelopment agencies, non-profit organizations, Indian tribes, and environmental protection entities.

Applications must be submitted by February 3, 2015.
