



REDESIGNED CALJOBSSM HOME PAGE

The Employment Development Department (EDD) is pleased to announce that the CalJOBS home page has been redesigned and the change will take effect September 12, 2016. Beginning on this date, the CalJOBS home page will be available for use by the EDD, Local Workforce Development Areas (Local Area), job seekers, and employers.

The redesigned CalJOBS home page displays a restructured appearance and includes increased functionality to promote accessibility of services or information and ease of use. Updates to the home page include the following:

- Identifies the State of California as the site owner and operator
- Explains that EDD and Local Area partners serve California's job seekers and employers at the America's Job Center of CaliforniaSM (AJCC) offices
- Guides users to appropriate services and information
- Clearly announces that all services are at no cost

Stating that there are no charges for any services provided at the AJCCs will immediately foster confidence and increase the likelihood that users will register and use CalJOBS.

The home page also features a new scrolling banner, which gives the EDD flexibility in adding information to publicize upcoming events, announcements, or pertinent news to all users of the CalJOBS system.
