USAJOBS connects job seekers with federal employment opportunities across the United States and around the world. As the Federal Government's official employment site, USAJOBS provides resources to help the right people find the right jobs.

As a part of the U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM), USAJOBS helps recruit, retain, and honor a world-class government workforce for the American people.

Federal agencies use USAJOBS to facilitate their hiring processes and match qualified applicants to job openings. Therefore, USAJOBS serves as the central location to find job openings within hundreds of federal agencies and organizations.

On February 27, 2018, it was announced that USAJOBS log in procedures have migrated to a new service that offers secure and private online access to government programs, such as federal benefits, services, and applications. With a login.gov account, you can sign into multiple government websites with the same email address and password.

If you previously had a USAJOBS account, you will now need to create a login.gov account. This service uses two-factor authentication, and stronger passwords, that meet new [National Institute of Standards of Technology](#) requirements for secure validation and verification. By using login.gov, you'll get an extra layer of security to help protect your USAJOBS profile against password compromises.
