



PATHWAY TO CITIZENSHIP PROGRAM FOR VETERANS

In partnership with the Governor’s Office and the California Department of Social Services, the California Department of Veterans Affairs (CalVet) launched an outreach initiative to educate unnaturalized veterans regarding state and federal benefits they earned based on their military service. For certain veterans, these benefits include expedited naturalization services.

As part of this initiative, the CalVet Minority Division is hosting veteran citizen workshops throughout California. These workshops offer no-cost legal assistance to veterans, service members, and their families to assist them with obtaining U.S. citizenship.
