PROJECT DESCRIPTION MICOP will provide radio and media strategies for outreach efforts and provide information to MSFWs and their families. Radio Indígena will produce and broadcast (24) 30-minutes radio segments broadcasting in Spanish with additional daily public service announcements in Spanish and indigenous languages identified in selected regions of California. The segment will air as part of the "Empoderando la Comunidad" radio program in live and recorded formats by Radio Indígena, Radio Bilingue, and Radio Campesina. Additionally, live streaming and recorded ondemand versions will be available in radio stations' websites and various dedicated social media channels. Cross marketing exercised on the radio and social media platforms and with partner organizations already

serving the MSFW community.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

Conduct outreach for hard-to-reach communities to highlight the EDD and partner programs and services that benefit California's farmworker

community.
