

## **Step 1** Apply for Unemployment Insurance Benefits

If you have lost your job through no fault of your own, or if your employer has reduced your hours, apply as soon as you can. Benefits are calculated from the filing date. You can apply online at eApply4UI.edd.ca.gov or call 1-800-300-5616.
