What is State Disability Insurance?

State Disability Insurance is a partial, short-term, wage-replacement insurance plan for California workers administered by the Employment Development Department (EDD) with two program components, Disability Insurance and Paid Family Leave.

Disability Insurance Benefits paid if your employee is unable to work their regular or customary job due to a non-work-related illness, injury, or pregnancy.

Paid Family Leave Benefits paid if your employee needs time off work to care for a seriously ill family member, bond with a new child, or assist their military family member with certain qualifying events.
