Tax Information: Form 1099G



What is a Form 1099G?

Form 1099G is a record of the total taxable income the Employment Development Department issued you in a calendar year, and is reported to the IRS.

You will receive a Form 1099G if you collected unemployment compensation from us and must report it on your federal tax return as income. Unemployment compensation is exempt from California state income tax.

Taxable unemployment compensation includes:

- Unemployment benefits, which include:
 - > Federal Extensions (FED-ED)
 - Lost Wages Assistance (LWA)
 - Pandemic Additional Compensation (PAC)
 - Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC)
 - ➤ Mixed Earner Unemployment Compensation (MEUC)
- Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) benefits
- Disability Insurance (DI) benefits received as a substitute for unemployment insurance benefits
- Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA) benefits
- Paid Family Leave (PFL) benefits

When will I get my Form 1099G?

We provide your Form 1099G by January 31 each year. We will mail you a paper form unless you choose electronic delivery by December 27. If you have a <u>UI Online</u> (edd.ca.gov/UI_Online) account, select **Profile** to update your Form 1099G Preferences.

Call 1-866-401-2849 if:

- You have a new mailing address. You can also change your contact information in your UI Online account or create an account with the correct information.
- A correction was made to your Form 1099G. This information will not be available online.

How do I request a copy of my Form 1099G?


Form 1099G tax information is available for up to five years in <u>UI Online</u> (edd.ca.gov/UI_Online). You can print your 1099G information from UI Online or request a paper copy by following these steps:

- Log in to <u>Benefit Programs Online</u> (edd.ca.gov/en/bpo/) and select **UI Online**.
- 2. Select **Payments**, then **Form 1099G**, then **View** next to the desired year.
- 3. Select **Request Paper Copy** to request an official paper copy of your Form 1099G.
- Confirm your address on the Form 1099G Address Confirmation screen.
